

## Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) about PCA Summer Camp

Q: *Can I sign my child up for just one week?*

A: Our camp is separated into four two-week sessions. We ask that if you'd like to sign up for part of camp, that you do so by session. You wouldn't want your child to miss out on the field trip and cookout/dress up day that occurs on separate weeks.

Q: *Can I pay tuition according to my work pay schedule?*

A: PCA Summer Camp wants to be as accommodating as we can. To help with this, we offer three payment options: weekly, bi-weekly, and full balance payment.

Q: *When are tuition payments due?*

A: This depends on the question above. Depending on which payment option you choose, payments are always due on a Wednesday before a new week. If payment is not received on due date, your child will not be able to attend camp until full balance is received. A \$20 fee will be issued for any bounced checks.

Q: *How does your multiple child discount work?*

A: PCA Summer Camp offers a multiple child discount to families of three or more children. The first two children are full price, and the third child or more gets a 50% discount off of tuition.

Q: *My cousin would like to send her children to your camp, but does not go to PCA. Can her children still go?*

A: PCA Summer Camp is not only for our PCA families, but is also an outreach program. Non-PCA students can apply to go to camp, but would not receive the PCA family discount. Non-PCA families who wish to attend Summer Camp would have to agree and abide by the core Christian values that are required at Penn Christian Academy. They may also be asked to attend an informal interview/screening process.

Q: *What is ESC and how does it work?*

A: ESC stands for Extended School Care, and our summer camp is happy to offer it before and after camp hours. Morning ESC hours are from 7:30am - 9am. Children arriving between these times can be dropped off in a designated classroom located in the cafeteria. Summer Camp ends promptly at 3pm every day. Any campers that remain will be sent to ESC. Children can stay in ESC until 6pm.

Q: *What if I am running late and cannot make it there by 6:00pm?*

A: As a courtesy, we ask that all children be picked up by 5:45pm. We are very firm about our 6pm cut-off time. ESC staff put in long hours, and we want them to be able to get home to their families for dinner. ☺ If you cannot pick up your child by this time, you will be charged **\$1 per minute after 6pm.**
